Cairo * Aswan * Kom Ombo* Edfu * Luxor * Hurghada

9 Nights/ 10 Days

Daily programme:

Day 1: Arrive Cairo

You will be met upon arrival Cairo Airport and assisted through airport customs and formalities. Private transfer to your hotel.

Check in upon arrival the hotel.

Overnight Cairo

Day 2: Full day Pyramids of Memphis, Saqqara, and Giza

Breakfast at the hotel in Cairo then start a guided tour to visit one of the Seven Wonders the great Pyramids of Giza: (Cheops, Chephren and Mycerinus). The Cheops Pyramid is more interesting, because its interior burial chambers are open for inspection by the public. Not far from the Pyramids is the Great Sphinx of Giza, which dates from the time of Chephren, this unforgettable statue combines the head of a Pharaoh with a lion's body. A quick visit to papyrus institute or a perfume shop can be arranged after the visit.

Continue the tour to visit the pyramids of Memphis and Saqqara area.

Memphis: The oldest capital of Egypt, was built by King Menes, and lays 24 kms southwest of Cairo. This is the most beautiful representation of Ramses II.

Sakkara: Is the oldest Ancient Egyptian cemetery. It lies on a desert plateau, southwest of Cairo. Drive back to your hotel in Cairo for refreshment.

Overnight Cairo

Day 3: The Citadel and Khan El Khalili

Breakfast at the hotel in Cairo then start a guided tour to visit the Citadel & Mohamed Ali Mosque. You will be escorted to a fascinating maze of little streets, filled with numerous old monuments and mosques from Cairo's Islamic past. Saladin's Citadel, the impressive 19th century Mosque of Mohammed Ali, and considered the oldest university in the world.

Continue the tour to visit the Egyptian Museum. The museum exhibited collections ranges from prehistoric era to the Greco Roman period. It has 107 halls, and the ground floor houses huge statues. The museum also comprises of a photography section and large library.

After the visit a short drive will take you to Khan El Khalili bazaars, which is one of the most famous worldwide with its amazing narrow alleyways. The bazaar is the domain of shopkeepers and tourists. Jewellers, items made from copper, parquetry boxes, semi-precious stones, rugs, and other souvenirs.

Drive back to your hotel in Cairo for refreshment.

Evening, pick-up from hotel and transfer for dinner on board Nile cruise -sail for 2 hours with folkloric oriental show and belly dancer.

Overnight Cairo

Day 4: Cairo - Aswan

Breakfast in the hotel, check out and transfer to the airport for your flight to Aswan. Duration of the flight is around 80 minutes.

You will be met upon arrival and transferred to the Nile Cruise for check in on board.

Lunch on board

Visit the High Dam and Philae temple with a local English-speaking guide.

High Dam: is certainly not the largest in the world, it is an impressive engineering feat nonetheless, over 360 feet tall and 12,500 feet across. The dam was completed in 1971 and the huge reservoir behind it, named for President Nasser.

Philae Temple: This beautiful temple complex is one of the most picturesque in all of Egypt. It sits on Aglika Island just south of the old Aswan Dam and you must ride a water taxi to the island to get to the ruins.

Back to Nile cruise and dinner on board.

Overnight on board

Day 5: Aswan – Kom Ombo

Breakfast on board

Sail to Kom Ombo. Lunch on board.

Visit Kom Ombo temple.

Kom Ombo Temple: it is the third major stop that most of the Nile cruises between Luxor and Aswan, dedicated to the crocodile-god Sobek. The temple stands at a bend in the Nile where in ancient times sacred crocodiles basked in the sun on the riverbank.

Sail to Edfu. Dinner on board.

Overnight on board

Day 6: Edfu - Luxor

Breakfast on board

Visit Horus temple in Edfu

Edfu Temple: it is the largest and most completely preserved Pharaonic temple in Egypt, the extraordinary Temple of Horus at Edfu. It is located in the centre of the town of Edfu.

Sail to Luxor via Esna. Lunch on board

Visit East bank of Luxor (Luxor temple and Karnak temples)

Karnak Temple: Built over a period of two millennia by generations of Pharaohs. Temple of Karnak was dedicated to the God Amun. It could take days to explore all the numerous pylons, obelisks, and smaller temples within.

Luxor Temple: it was once connected to Karnak via the Avenue of Human-headed Sphinxes, almost 3 kilometres in length. It is considered as a mark of Ancient Egyptian civilization, strikingly graceful monument in the heart of modern Luxor. It is one of the best-preserved of all the ancient monuments making it one of the most impressive places to visit in Luxor area and all of Egypt.

Day 7: Luxor - Hurghada

Overnight on board

Breakfast on board and check out.

Commence a guided tour to visit the West bank of Luxor (Valley of Kings, Hatshepsut temple and Colossi of Memnon).

Valley of the Kings: a vast City of the Dead where magnificent tombs were carved into the desert rocks, as it was used for royal burials for the Kings. It is the most famous site for having unique collections of tombs and breath-taking ancient ruins.

Entrance of 03 tombs from inside is included (Ramses I, Ramses IX and Merenptah).

Hatshepsut Temple: Rising out of the desert plain in a series of terraces, the Temple of Queen Hatshepsut (Ancient Egypt's only female Pharaoh) merges with the sheer limestone cliffs that surround it, as if nature herself had built this extraordinary monument.

Colossi of Memnon: On the way back to the river Nile, your

road passes by the famed Colossi of Memnon, known in Ancient Greek times for their haunting voices at dawn. They were constructed as guardians for Amenhotep III's mortuary complex.

End the tour and transfer to Hurghada by road, around 4 hours .

Arrive Hurghada and transfer to hotel for check in.

Overnight Hurghada.

Day 8: Hurghada

Breakfast at the hotel. Day at leisure to enjoy the sun and sea of Hurghada.

All – Inclusive meal basis

Overnight Hurghada.

Day 9: Hurghada

Breakfast at the hotel. Day at leisure to enjoy the sun and sea of Hurghada.

Overnight Hurghada.

Day 10: Depart Hurghada

Breakfast at the hotel and check out.

Transfer to Cairo airport for your international flight connection back home.
